11	WHEREAS, with the conclusion of the 2019-2022
12	quadrennium of the Legislature of Alabama, Representative Mike
13	Jones will end his tenure in the Alabama House of
14	Representatives; and
15	WHEREAS, following his graduation from Andalusia
16	High School, Representative Jones attended Lurleen B. Wallace
17	State Junior College and then Birmingham-Southern College
18	until his graduation with a Bachelor's Degree; after earning
19	his Juris Doctor from the University of Alabama School of Law,
20	Representative Jones served on the city council of his home
21	city of Andalusia from 2000 to 2008, and served as Mayor Pro
22	Tempore of Andalusia from 2004 to 2008; and
23	WHEREAS, Representative Jones was first elected to
24	represent his home area of Andalusia in the House of
25	Representatives in 2010; for five of those years,
26	Representative Jones has served as Chair of the House Rules
27	Committee, one of the most powerful positions in the

Legislature; he has also served on the Energy Council, the executive committee of the Alabama Law Institute, and has chaired the House Judiciary Committee, where he leveraged his legal background to help shape bills involving the courts, the Legislature, and the practice of law; it was in that role that Representative Jones shaped the process for and presided over the first impeachment investigation of a constitutional officer in Alabama in over 100 years, and in doing so shaped a process that was fair, transparent, and comprehensive, even if at one point he put his lawyer at risk of a contempt order; additionally, Representative Jones has served on the Alabama Sentencing Commission and the Criminal Justice Oversight and Implementation Council; and

WHEREAS, during his time in the House of
Representatives, Representative Jones frequently maintained
that he reads every bill; whether this was for his own
purposes or for legislative charity, no one can truly say;
however, his familiarity with almost every piece of
legislation has benefitted the entire chamber on numerous
occasions, as he is always willing to speak at the microphone,
lend his legal expertise towards debates, and even amend a
bill from time to time - again, for good or for bad; and

WHEREAS, Representative Jones is currently a practicing attorney and municipal court judge in Andalusia, a fact few of his colleagues know; he and his wife, Kathy Harper Jones, have proudly reared two daughters, Olivia and Sophia; together as a family, they attend First Baptist Church, where

leadership positions and titles, Representative Jones might be
