A BILL

To amend the Outer Continental Shelf Lands Act to permanently prohibit the conduct of offshore drilling on the outer Continental Shelf in the Mid-Atlantic, South Atlantic, North Atlantic, and Straits of Florida planning areas.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Clean Ocean And Safe
- 5 Tourism Anti-Drilling Act" or the "COAST Anti-Drilling
- 6 Act".

1	SEC. 2. PROHIBITION OF OIL AND GAS LEASING IN CER-
2	TAIN AREAS OF THE OUTER CONTINENTAL
3	SHELF.
4	Section 8 of the Outer Continental Shelf Lands Act
5	(43 U.S.C. 1337) is amended by adding at the end the
6	following:
7	"(q) Prohibition of Oil and Gas Leasing in
8	CERTAIN AREAS OF THE OUTER CONTINENTAL SHELF.—
9	Notwithstanding any other provision of this section or any
10	other law, the Secretary of the Interior shall not issue a
11	lease or any other authorization for the exploration, devel-
12	opment, or production of oil, natural gas, or any other
13	mineral in—
14	"(1) the Mid-Atlantic planning area;
15	"(2) the South Atlantic planning area;
16	"(3) the North Atlantic planning area; or
17	"(4) the Straits of Florida planning area.".
