#### A BILL

To establish the Springfield Race Riot National Historic Monument in the State of Illinois, and for other purposes.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Springfield Race Riot
5	Study Act".
6	SEC. 2. RESOURCE STUDY OF SPRINGFIELD RACE RIOT.
7	(a) Definitions.—In this section:
8	(1) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
9	the Secretary of the Interior.
10	(2) Study area" means
11	areas identified in the Springfield Race Riot Recon-
12	naissance Survey conducted by the National Park
13	Service, dated August 2019.
14	(b) Special Resource Study.—
15	(1) Study.—The Secretary shall conduct a spe-
16	cial resource study of the study area.
17	(2) Contents.—In conducting the study under
18	paragraph (1), the Secretary shall—
19	(A) evaluate the national significance of the
20	study area;
21	(B) determine the suitability and feasibility
22	of designating the study area as a unit of the
23	National Park System;
24	(C) consider other alternatives for preserva-
25	tion, protection, and interpretation of the study

1	area by the Federal Government, State or local
2	government entities, or private and nonprofit or-
3	ganizations;
4	(D) consult with interested Federal agen-
5	cies, State or local governmental entities, private
6	and nonprofit organizations, or any other inter-
7	ested individuals; and
8	(E) identify cost estimates for any Federal
9	acquisition, development, interpretation, oper-
10	ation, and maintenance associated with the al-
11	ternatives.
12	(3) Applicable law.—The study required
13	under paragraph (1) shall be conducted in accordance
14	with section 100507 of title 54, United States Code.
15	(4) Report.—Not later than 3 years after the
16	date on which funds are first made available for the
17	study under paragraph (1), the Secretary shall sub-
18	mit to the Committee on Natural Resources of the
19	House of Representatives and the Committee on En-
20	ergy and Natural Resources of the Senate a report
21	that describes—
22	(A) the results of the study; and
23	(B) any conclusions and recommendations
24	of the Secretary.

Amend the title so as to read: "A bill to direct the Secretary of Interior to conduct a special resource study of the site associated with the 1908 Springfield Race Riot in the State of Illinois, and for other purposes.".
