CONCERNING THE REPEAL OF AN OBSOLETE PROVISION THAT REQUIRED THE
DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT TO AWARD
GRANTS BY JULY 2007.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, **repeal** part 13 of article 1 of title 25.

SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in

November 2026 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
