2	Be i	t enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3		→ Section 1. KRS 337.015 is amended to read as follows:
4	<u>(1)</u>	Upon receiving written request by an employee, every employer shall grant
5		reasonable personal leave not to exceed six (6) weeks, or if the employer has
6		established a policy providing time off for birth parents that is greater than six (6)
7		weeks, that period of time shall be the minimum period of leave available to
8		adoptive parents, when the reception of an adoptive child under the age of ten
9		(10)[seven $(7)$ ] is the reason for such request.
10	<u>(2)</u>	If an employer provides paid leave or any other benefits to employees who are
11		birth parents following the birth of a child, it shall also provide the same type,
12		amount, and duration of paid leave and other benefits to employees following the
13		adoption of a child.
14	<u>(3)</u>	This section shall not apply to an adoption by a fictive kin, stepparent, stepsibling,
15		blood relative, including a relative of halfblood, first cousin, aunt, uncle, nephew,
16		niece, and a person of a preceding generation as denoted by prefixes of grand,
17		great, or great-great, or a foster parent who adopts a foster child who is already
18		in their care.
