A BILL

To prohibit any entity from imposing a mandate that individuals be vaccinated against COVID–19, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No COVID–19 Vac-
5 cination Mandate Act of 2021”.

6 **SEC. 2. NO MANDATES FOR VACCINATION AGAINST COVID–**

8 Notwithstanding any Federal or State law, no institu-
9 tion or other entity, including any such Federal, State,
10 local, Tribal, or private entity, may establish, implement,

1 or enforce any mandate (including as a condition of em-
2 ployment, enrollment or attendance at school, or receipt
3 of services) that any individual be vaccinated against
4 SARS-Cov-2 or COVID-19.
