

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2018. It shall remain effective for a period of [11] **16** years and, at the end of June 30, [2029] **2034**, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
