A BILL

To prohibit the use of Federal funds to establish, support, or otherwise promote a joint cybersecurity initiative with Russia, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "No Cyber Cooperation
- 5 with Russia Act".

1	SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS FOR
2	JOINT CYBERSECURITY INITIATIVE WITH
3	RUSSIA.
4	No Federal funds may be used to establish, support,
5	or otherwise promote, directly or indirectly, the formation
6	of or any United States participation in a joint cybersecu-
7	rity initiative involving the Government of Russia or any
8	entity operating under the direction of the Government of
9	Russia.
