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WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the 135th General Assembly
of Ohio were deeply saddened to learn of the death of Dan Ramos and
extend our heartfelt condolences to his family and friends; and

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WHEREAS, Dan Ramos left an indelible impression on the people
whose lives he touched, and he will be remembered as a spirited
individual who contributed immeasurably to the world around him. Among
his endeavors, he served as a policy analyst for former Speaker Armond
Budish and Minority Leader Joyce Beatty before being elected to the
first of four terms as a member of the Ohio House of Representatives
in 2010, and he became the first person of Latino descent to hold a
leadership post when he was selected as deputy whip by his peers in
2013; and

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WHEREAS, Dan Ramos' regard for improving the quality of life in
our society was clearly evident in his personal sacrifices of time and
effort to his family, friends, and community. Giving generously of his
energy and abilities in all of his endeavors, he displayed exceptional
concern and insight, and his absence will be keenly felt; and

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WHEREAS, In numerous roles, Dan Ramos always used his talents to
the benefit of others, and the laurels of his life stand as a tribute
not only to him but also to those he left behind. Although the void
his death has created can never be filled, the legacy of care and
commitment he established will surely live on. The world is a richer
