- (a) An employer in the teachers' retirement system (AS 14.25) that does 6 7 not participate in the federal social security system may become a participating 8 employer in the employee benefits program under AS 39.30.150 - 39.30.180 [, IF 9 (1) THE EMPLOYER PARTICIPATES AS AN EMPLOYER IN THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM UNDER AS 39.35; AND 10 11 (2) THE EMPLOYER 12 IS ELIGIBLE FOR MEMBERSHIP IN BUT HAS 13 NEVER ELECTED TO BECOME A MEMBER OF THE FEDERAL 14 SOCIAL SECURITY SYSTEM; OR

1	(B) WITHDRAWS FROM MEMBERSHIP IN THE
2	FEDERAL SOCIAL SECURITY SYSTEM].
