BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Natural Resources Section 1-102(c)(2)Annotated Code of Maryland (2018 Replacement Volume and 2022 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Natural Resources 1-102.[The] SUBJECT TO SUBSUBPARAGRAPH 2 OF THIS (c) (2) (i) 1. SUBPARAGRAPH, THE Wildlife Advisory Commission is composed of nine 10 members appointed by the Governor.
