A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **University of Maryland, Baltimore Campus – Employees – Authorization to**
3 **Fund–Raise**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing an employee of the University of Maryland, Baltimore
5 Campus to solicit gifts or proposals for grants for the benefit of the University of
6 Maryland Medical System Corporation in accordance with certain provisions of law
7 and policies; and generally relating to University of Maryland, Baltimore Campus
8 employees and fund–raising.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – Education**

22 13–303.

23 (j) The Board of Directors will coordinate with University fund–raising efforts all
24 Medical System Corporation campaigns and solicitations for private gifts and proposals for
25 private or federal grants.

2 **NOTWITHSTANDING §§ 5-505 AND 5-506 OF THE GENERAL PROVISIONS**
3 **ARTICLE, AN EMPLOYEE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND, BALTIMORE CAMPUS**
4 **MAY SOLICIT GIFTS OR PROPOSALS FOR GRANTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE**
5 **UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND MEDICAL SYSTEM CORPORATION IN ACCORDANCE**
6 **WITH § 13-303(J) OF THIS TITLE AND THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND, BALTIMORE**
7 **CAMPUS'S POLICIES REGARDING COORDINATING FUND-RAISING BETWEEN THE**
8 **UNIVERSITY AND THE MEDICAL SYSTEM CORPORATION.**

9 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect**
10 **October 1, 2022.**
