St. Mary's County - Motor Vehicle Registration - Exception for Golf Carts

- 3 FOR the purpose of creating an exception from motor vehicle registration requirements, 4 under certain circumstances, for golf carts in St. Mary's County; providing that a 5 person who operates a golf cart on a county highway in St. Mary's County may 6 operate the golf cart only on certain roads at certain times and only if the golf cart is 7 equipped with certain lighting devices; requiring a person who operates a golf cart 8 on a county highway in St. Mary's County to keep as far to the right of the roadway 9 as feasible and possess a valid driver's license; authorizing the St. Mary's County Board of Commissioners to designate the county highways on which a person may 10 11 operate a golf cart in St. Mary's County; providing for the application of this Act; and 12 generally relating to an exception to motor vehicle registration requirements for golf carts in St. Mary's County. 13

5 6 7	(a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section or elsewhere in the Maryland Vehicle Law, each motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, and pole trailer driven on a highway shall be registered under this subtitle.
8 9	(2) If a motor vehicle required to be registered under this subtitle is not registered, a person may not park the unregistered motor vehicle on any:
10	(i) Public alley, street, or highway; or
11 12	(ii) Private property used by the public in general, including parking lots of shopping centers, condominiums, apartments, or town house developments.
13 14 15	(3) The provisions of paragraph (2) of this subsection do not apply to a motor vehicle that is exempt from registration under this section or $\S 13-402.1$ of this subtitle.
16	(c) Registration under this subtitle is not required for:

18 19 20	(i) In conformity with the provisions of this title relating to manufacturers, transporters, dealers, secured parties, owners or operators of special mobile equipment, or nonresidents; or

23 24	(2) A vehicle owned and used by the United States, unless an authorized officer or employee of the United States requests registration of the vehicle;
25	(3) A farm tractor or any farm equipment;
26	(4) A vehicle the front or rear wheels of which are lifted from the highway;
27 28	(5) A towed vehicle that is attached to the towing vehicle by a tow bar and for which no driver is necessary;
29 30	(6) A vehicle owned by and in the possession of a licensed dealer for purpose of sale;

- 1 (III) IF THE GOLF CART IS EQUIPPED WITH LIGHTING DEVICES 2 AS REQUIRED BY THE ADMINISTRATION;
- 3 (2) SHALL KEEP THE GOLF CART AS FAR TO THE RIGHT OF THE 4 ROADWAY AS FEASIBLE; AND
- 5 (3) SHALL POSSESS A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE.
- 6 (C) THE ST. MARY'S COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MAY DESIGNATE 7 THE COUNTY HIGHWAYS ON WHICH A PERSON MAY OPERATE A GOLF CART.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 9 1, 2021.
