A BILL

To prohibit certain Federal agencies from requiring that any employee of such an agency receive a COVID-19 vaccine, and for other purposes.

- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Protecting Our Federal
- 5 Workforce from Forced COVID-19 Vaccination Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION AGAINST AGENCY VACCINE MAN-
- 7 DATES.
- 8 (a) Definition.—In this section, the term "agency"
- 9 means an executive department, agency, or independent
- 10 establishment that is subject to the requirements of Exec-

- 1 utive Order 14042 (86 Fed. Reg. 50985; relating to ensur-
- 2 ing adequate COVID safety protocols for Federal contrac-
- 3 tors).
- 4 (b) Prohibition.—No agency may require any em-
- 5 ployee of the agency, or any individual working on or in
- 6 connection with a contract or subcontract with respect to
- 7 the agency, to receive a COVID-19 vaccine.
