A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act providing the Alaska State Council on the Arts the authority to adopt**
2 **regulations relating to its statutory powers and duties; and providing for an effective**
3 **date."**

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 * **Section 1.** AS 44.27.052(a) is amended to read:

6 (a) The council may

7 (1) hold public and private hearings;

8 (2) enter into contracts, within the limit of funds available, with
9 individuals, organizations, and institutions for services furthering the educational
10 objectives of the council's programs;

11 (3) enter into contracts, within the limit of funds available, with local
12 and regional associations for cooperative endeavors furthering the educational
13 objectives of the council's programs;

14 (4) accept gifts, contributions, and bequests of unrestricted funds from

1 individuals, foundations, corporations, and other organizations or institutions for the
2 purpose of furthering the educational objectives of the council's programs; [AND]

3 (5) make and sign agreements and do and perform any acts necessary
4 to carry out the purposes of AS 44.27.040 - 44.27.060; and

5 (6) adopt regulations under AS 44.62 (Administrative Procedure
6 Act) to carry out the provisions of AS 44.27.040 - 44.27.060.

7 * **Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
