- An Act to prohibit a school district from offering a reward to or imposing disciplinary action on a student to incentivize the return of required parental consent forms.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
 - Section 1. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 13-32:

A superintendent, principal, teacher, or other individual having disciplinary authority over a student may not subject a student to disciplinary action for failing to return any routine consent form contained in a school handbook, which is required to be signed annually by a parent or quardian at the beginning of a school year.

A superintendent, principal, teacher, or other individual having disciplinary authority over a student may not reward or otherwise incentivize a student for returning any completed routine consent form contained in a school handbook, which is required to be signed annually by a parent or guardian at the beginning of a school year.
