## Public Schools - Virtual Education Days - Authorization

- 3 FOR the purpose of providing that a county board of education may authorize a county 4 superintendent of schools, under certain circumstances, to provide virtual education 5 days to students instead of closing the public schools in the county because of severe 6 weather conditions; requiring the county board to publish the county board's plan for 7 the use of virtual education days on the school system's website and requiring the plan to include certain items; requiring a county superintendent to take certain 8 9 actions and make certain accommodations if the county superintendent decides to 10 provide a virtual education day for public school students in the county; and 11 generally relating to days of virtual education.

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 1 (A) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A COUNTY BOARD MAY
  2 AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT, IN CASES OF SEVERE WEATHER
  3 CONDITIONS, TO PROVIDE VIRTUAL EDUCATION DAYS TO STUDENTS INSTEAD OF
  4 CLOSING THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN THE COUNTY DURING A SEVERE WEATHER EVENT.
- 5 (B) BEFORE A COUNTY BOARD MAY AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY 6 SUPERINTENDENT TO PROVIDE VIRTUAL EDUCATION DAYS TO STUDENTS IN 7 ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL:
- 8 (1) DISCUSS THIS TOPIC AT AN OPEN MEETING; AND
- 9 (2) VOTE AFFIRMATIVELY TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY 10 SUPERINTENDENT TO PROVIDE VIRTUAL EDUCATION DAYS TO STUDENTS DURING A 11 SEVERE WEATHER EVENT.
- 12 (C) (1) A COUNTY BOARD SHALL PUBLISH THE COUNTY BOARD'S PLAN
  13 FOR THE USE OF VIRTUAL EDUCATION DAYS ON THE SCHOOL SYSTEM'S WEBSITE.
- 14 (2) THE COUNTY BOARD'S PLAN PUBLISHED IN ACCORDANCE WITH 15 PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL INCLUDE:
- 16 (I) A PLAN TO ENSURE THAT ATTENDANCE WILL BE TAKEN FOR
  17 ALL STUDENTS AND TEACHERS DURING EACH VIRTUAL EDUCATION DAY;
- 18 <u>(II) A PLAN TO PROVIDE OPPORTUNITIES FOR STUDENTS TO</u>
  19 <u>MAKE UP WORK MISSED DURING VIRTUAL EDUCATION DAYS WHEN THEY RETURN TO</u>
  20 IN-PERSON SCHOOL;
- 21 (III) A PLAN TO ENSURE THAT ALL STAFF AND STUDENTS,
- 22 INCLUDING STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES, HOMELESS STUDENTS, AND ENGLISH
- 23 LANGUAGE LEARNERS, HAVE THE NECESSARY DEVICES AT HOME FOR VIRTUAL
- 24 EDUCATION DAYS, INCLUDING ACCESS TO WI-FI; AND
- 25 (IV) SPECIFIC STRATEGIES FOR THE CONTINUED
- 26 <u>IMPLEMENTATION OF INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PROGRAMS DURING THE</u>
- 27 <u>VIRTUAL EDUCATION DAY, INCLUDING SPECIALLY DESIGNED INSTRUCTION,</u>
- 28 RELATED SERVICES, SUPPLEMENTARY AIDES AND SERVICES, AND
- 29 ACCOMMODATIONS.
- 30 (C) (D) A COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT MAY DECIDE TO PROVIDE A DAY OF VIRTUAL EDUCATION FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS IN THE COUNTY ONLY IF:

- 1 (1) THE LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM HAS USED ALL THE DAYS 2 INCORPORATED INTO ITS CALENDAR FOR SCHOOL CLOSURES FOR SEVERE
- 3 WEATHER CONDITIONS;
- 4 (2) THE COUNTY BOARD HAS AUTHORIZED THE COUNTY
- 5 SUPERINTENDENT TO PROVIDE VIRTUAL EDUCATION DAYS TO STUDENTS IN
- 6 ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION; AND
- 7 (3) THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT DETERMINES THAT SEVERE
- 8 WEATHER CONDITIONS ARE LIKELY TO PREVENT NORMAL ATTENDANCE AT THE
- 9 PUBLIC SCHOOL.
- 10 (D) (E) (1) IF A COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT DECIDES TO PROVIDE A
- 11 VIRTUAL EDUCATION DAY FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS IN THE COUNTY, THE
- 12 COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT SHALL NOTIFY THE SCHOOL PRINCIPALS AS SOON AS
- 13 POSSIBLE AFTER THE DECISION IS MADE.
- 14 (2) A SCHOOL PRINCIPAL WHO RECEIVES NOTICE OF A VIRTUAL
- 15 EDUCATION DAY IMMEDIATELY SHALL NOTIFY THE STUDENTS, PARENTS, AND
- 16 SCHOOL STAFF OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE VIRTUAL EDUCATION DAY.
- 17 (E) (F) (1) A VIRTUAL EDUCATION DAY SHALL CONSIST OF
- 18 SYNCHRONOUS NOT LESS THAN 4 HOURS OF SYNCHRONOUS INSTRUCTION, AND
- 19 ASYNCHRONOUS INSTRUCTION DESIGNED TO MAXIMIZE THE ADVANTAGES OF
- 20 ONLINE ACCESS.
- 21 (2) A PUBLIC SCHOOL THAT IMPLEMENTS A VIRTUAL EDUCATION DAY
- 22 SHALL MAKE ACCOMMODATIONS FOR STUDENTS AND SCHOOL STAFF WHO DO NOT
- 23 HAVE EASY ACCESS TO THE INTERNET.
- 24 (3) (2) A COUNTY BOARD THAT AUTHORIZES A COUNTY
- 25 SUPERINTENDENT TO PROVIDE A VIRTUAL EDUCATION DAY SHALL ADEQUATELY
- 26 DESIGN THE VIRTUAL EDUCATION DAY MODEL BEFORE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE
- 27 FIRST VIRTUAL EDUCATION DAY.
- 28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
- 29 1, 2022.
