6	Whereas, increasing the number of assistant principals in schools will increase the
7	number of well-prepared principals in public schools; Now, therefore,
8	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
9	SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-47 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
10	"(70) To Provide for Assistant Principals. – Local boards of education shall increase
11	full-time, permanent assistant principal positions employed in local school
12	administrative units based on average daily membership for each fiscal year
13	until the 2026-2027 fiscal year. Beginning in the 2025-2026 fiscal year, in
14	order to increase assistant principal positions under this subdivision, there is
15	appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction
16	for the following fiscal years the following amounts to the school building
17	administration allotment to increase the ratios of funds allotted for months of
18	employment for assistant principals to students, as follows:
19	Fiscal Year Assistant Principals Appropriation
20	2025-2026 <u>1 month:90 students</u> \$23,560,043
21	<u>2026-2027</u>
22	and each subsequent
23 24	fiscal year thereafter 1 month:80 students \$57,568,035."
24 25	SECTION 2. Funds provided pursuant to this act shall supplement and not supplant
25 26	any funds from any source already provided for assistant principals. SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2025. Section 1 of this act applies
