- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. TRIGGER LEAD PROHIBITION.
- 4 Section 604(c) of the Fair Credit Reporting Act (15
- 5 U.S.C. 1681b(c)) is amended by adding at the end the
- 6 following:
- 7 "(4) Prohibition on Trigger leads for
- 8 RESIDENTIAL MORTGAGE LOANS.—Notwithstanding
- 9 paragraph (1), no consumer reporting agency may
- furnish a consumer report in connection with a cred-

it transaction that is not initiated by a consumer, if
the report is being procured based in whole or in
part on the presence of an inquiry made in connection with a residential mortgage loan (as defined
under section 103 of the Truth in Lending Act (15
U.S.C. 1602)).".
