A BILL

To amend the Trade Act of 1974 to modify provisions relating to withdrawal, suspension, or limitation of country designation under the Generalized System of Preferences.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3 SECTION 1. MODIFICATION OF PROVISIONS RELATING TO
4 WITHDRAWAL, SUSPENSION, OR LIMITATION
5 OF COUNTRY DESIGNATION UNDER THE GEN6 ERALIZED SYSTEM OF PREFERENCES.
7 Section 502(d)(1) of the Trade Act of 1974 (19
8 U.S.C. (2462(d)(1)) is amended—

1	(1) by striking "the President shall consider the
2	factors" and inserting "the President—
3	"(A) shall consider—
4	"(i) the factors";
5	(2) by striking the period at the end and insert-
6	ing a semicolon; and
7	(3) by adding at the end the following:
8	"(ii) the likely impacts of any such ac-
9	tion on working toward, or continuing to
10	meet, the criteria and factors described in
11	subsections (b) and (c) of this section; and
12	"(iii) the likely impacts of any such
13	action on workers and populations in the
14	country that such criteria and factors are
15	intended to help; and
16	"(B) take all available steps to facilitate
17	continued duty-free treatment under this title
18	for products with respect to which the imposi-
19	tion of duties is likely—
20	"(i) to have an adverse effect or
21	meeting the criteria and factors described
22	in subsections (b) and (c) of this section
23	or

1	"(ii) result in severe economic harm
2	to the populations that such criteria and
3	factors are intended to help.".
