A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Environment – Wetlands – Landward Boundaries**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain land created under a tidal wetlands license to be
4 described in a certain manner; requiring the Department of the Environment to
5 update, to a certain standard, the landward boundaries of certain wetlands following
6 the completion of improvements consisting of certain shoreline stabilization
7 measures; and generally relating to wetlands.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Environment**

21 16–103.

22 (a) Except as specifically provided in this title, a riparian owner may not be
23 deprived of any right, privilege, or enjoyment of riparian ownership that the riparian owner
24 had prior to July 1, 1970.

(b) The provisions of this title do not transfer the title or ownership of any land or interest in land.

(C) ANY FAST LAND CREATED UNDER A TIDAL WETLANDS LICENSE SHALL BE DESCRIBED BY METES AND BOUNDS.

(A) (1) FOLLOWING THE COMPLETION OF ANY IMPROVEMENTS CONSISTING OF SHORELINE STABILIZATION MEASURES AUTHORIZED UNDER § 16-201(C) OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PRECISELY UPDATE THE LANDWARD BOUNDARIES OF THE RELEVANT WETLANDS.

(2) THE LANDWARD BOUNDARIES OF THE WETLANDS SHALL BE SHOWN ON SUITABLE MAPS OR AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHS ON A SCALE OF 1 INCH TO 200 FEET.

(B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2025.
