COMMENDING OFFICERS WYTASHA CARTER, WALLACE RUSSELL, SHAUN DEANE, THOMAS LUCAS, JOHN SWINNEY, MARLON TOLLIVER, STEPHEN MOORE, FREDERICK WESLEY, FRANK ALEXANDER, VONRIC SLAUGHTER, AND PAUL IRWIN OF THE BIRMINGHAM POLICE DEPARTMENT AS NOMINEES FOR THE 2017 ALABAMA LEGISLATIVE MEDAL OF HONOR FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT.

WHEREAS, it is with highest commendations that we recognize Officers Wytasha Carter, Wallace Russell, Shaun Deane, Thomas Lucas, John Swinney, Marlon Tolliver, Stephen Moore, Frederick Wesley, Frank Alexander, Vonric Slaughter, and Paul Irwin of the Birmingham Police Department as nominees for the 2017 Alabama Legislative Medal of Honor for Law Enforcement, Alabama's highest law enforcement award for extraordinary courage in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, on April 14, 2017, officers were dispatched to a residence where the roof had collapsed with several children trapped inside; several officers rushed to the front entrance and were informed by the grandmother that two little girls were trapped inside the home; officers began uncovering the little girls by hand while keeping the surrounding wood, roofing, and chimney materials from falling. The first child, a five-year-old girl, was removed from inside a couch while

other officers and firefighters lifted several pieces of metal from inside the chimney along with other roofing materials; the officers continued to work desperately to remove the second child who was buried in the debris and appeared to be unconscious; Birmingham Fire and Rescue began resuscitation efforts and put her on a back board; and

WHEREAS, if it had not been for the actions of these officers and the Birmingham Fire and Rescue Service, two little girls would have died; although the scene was in chaos, each officer gave 100 percent and worked as a team to save these little girls; the images and cries for help will be something that none of them will ever forget; the rescue and recovery will be something everyone involved will carry in their heart; and

WHEREAS, the actions of Officers Wytasha Carter,
Wallace Russell, Shaun Deane, Thomas Lucas, John Swinney,
Marlon Tolliver, Stephen Moore, Frederick Wesley, Frank
Alexander, Vonric Slaughter, and Paul Irwin had a tremendous
impact on the neighborhood as demonstrated by the neighbors'
responses to the actions that occurred on the scene; their
actions represent the high standards of the Birmingham Police
Department and its goal to protect the citizens and visitors
in the City of Birmingham; now therefore,
