A BILL

To amend the Safe Drinking Water Act to extend and expand the provision requiring the use of iron and steel products that are produced in the United States in projects funded through a State drinking water treatment revolving loan fund.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Buy America for
5 Drinking Water Extension Act of 2017”.

1 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT FOR USE OF AMERICAN MATERIALS.**

2 Subparagraph (A) of section 1452(a)(4) of the Safe
3 Drinking Water Act (42 U.S.C. 300j–12(a)(4)) is amend-
4 ed to read as follows:

5 “(A) IN GENERAL.—Funds made available
6 from a State drinking water treatment revolv-
7 ing loan fund established under this section
8 may not be used for a project for the construc-
9 tion, alteration, maintenance, or repair of col-
10 lection, treatment, storage, and distribution fa-
11 cilities, including publicly and privately owned
12 pipes or other constructed conveyances, unless
13 all of the iron and steel products used in the
14 project are produced in the United States.”.

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
