1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Information Act – Surveillance Images – Illegal Dumping in Baltimore**
3 **City**

4 FOR the purpose of repealing a certain provision of law requiring a custodian to deny
5 inspection of certain surveillance images of illegal dumping in Baltimore City except
6 under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the inspection of surveillance
7 images of illegal dumping in Baltimore City.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – General Provisions**

16 [4–322.

17 (a) In this section, “surveillance image” has the meaning stated in § 10–112 of the
18 Criminal Law Article.

19 (b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, a custodian of a
20 surveillance image shall deny inspection of the surveillance image.

21 (c) A custodian shall allow inspection of a surveillance image:

22 (1) as required in § 10–112 of the Criminal Law Article;

1 (2) by any person issued a citation under § 10–112 of the Criminal Law
2 Article, or by an attorney of record for the person; or

3 (3) by an employee or agent of the Baltimore City Department of Public
4 Works in an investigation or a proceeding relating to the imposition of or indemnification
5 from civil liability under § 10–112 of the Criminal Law Article.】

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
7 October 1, 2024.
