## A BILL

To repeal the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act and the Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010 entirely.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "ObamaCare Repeal
- 5 Act".

- 20 shall be determined by reference to the latest statement
- 21 titled "Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation" for this
- 22 Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record
- 23 by the Chairman of the Committee on the Budget of the
- 24 House of Representatives, as long as such statement has
- 25 been submitted prior to the vote on passage of this Act.
