#### A BILL

To amend the Omnibus Parks and Public Lands Management Act of 1996 to provide for the establishment of a Ski Area Fee Retention Account, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

#### **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2	This Act may be cited as the "Ski Hill Resources for
3	Economic Development Act of 2021".
4	SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF SKI AREA FEE RETENTION AC
5	COUNT.
6	(a) In General.—Section 701 of division I of the
7	Omnibus Parks and Public Lands Management Act of
8	1996 (16 U.S.C. 497e) is amended by adding at the end
9	the following:
10	"(k) SKI AREA FEE RETENTION ACCOUNT.—
11	"(1) Definitions.—In this subsection:
12	"(A) ACCOUNT.—The term 'Account
13	means the Ski Area Fee Retention Account es-
14	tablished under paragraph (2).
15	"(B) COVERED UNIT.—The term 'covered
16	unit' means a unit of the National Forest Sys-
17	tem that collects a rental charge.
18	"(C) Program.—The term 'Program
19	means the Forest Service Ski Area Program.
20	"(D) REGION.—The term 'region' means a
21	region of the Forest Service.
22	"(E) RENTAL CHARGE.—The term 'rental
23	charge' means a permit rental charge that is
24	charged under subsection (a).
25	"(F) SECRETARY.—The term 'Secretary
26	means the Secretary of Agriculture.

1	"(2) ESTABLISHMENT.—The Secretary of the
2	Treasury shall establish in the Treasury a special
3	account, to be known as the 'Ski Area Fee Retention
4	Account', into which there shall be deposited—
5	"(A) in the case of a covered unit at which
6	\$15,000,000 or more is collected by the covered
7	unit from rental charges in a fiscal year, an
8	amount equal to 60 percent of the rental
9	charges collected at the covered unit in the fis-
10	eal year; or
11	"(B) in the case of any other covered unit,
12	an amount equal to 75 percent of the rental
13	charges collected at the covered unit in a fiscal
14	<del>year.</del>
15	"(3) AVAILABILITY.—Subject to paragraph (5),
16	any amounts deposited in the Account under para-
17	graph (2) shall be available to the Secretary for use
18	in accordance with paragraph (4), without further
19	appropriation, and shall remain available until ex-
20	<del>pended.</del>
21	"(4) Use and distribution of amounts in
22	THE ACCOUNT.—
23	"(A) DISTRIBUTION OF PERCENTAGE
24	AMOUNTS. Except as provided in subpara-
25	graphs (B), (C), (D), (F), and (G), 75 percent

1	of the amounts deposited in the Account from
2	a covered unit at which the rental charges were
3	collected in the preceding fiscal year shall be
4	available for expenditure in accordance with
5	subparagraph (E) at that covered unit.
6	"(B) REDUCTION OF PERCENTAGE
7	AMOUNT.—Subject to subparagraph (C), the
8	Secretary may reduce the percentage of
9	amounts available to a covered unit under sub-
10	paragraph (A) if the Secretary determines that
11	the amounts will exceed the reasonable needs of
12	the covered unit for the purposes described in
13	subparagraph (E) in the fiscal year.
14	"(C) Limitation.—The Secretary may not
15	reduce, pursuant to subparagraph (B), the per-
16	centage of amounts available under subpara-
17	graph (A)—
18	"(i) in the case of a covered unit de-
19	scribed in paragraph (2)(A), to less than
20	25 percent of the amount of rental charges
21	deposited in the Account from the covered
22	unit in a fiscal year; or
23	"(ii) in the case of any other covered
24	unit, to less than 40 percent of the amount

1	of rental charges deposited in the Account
2	from the covered unit in a fiscal year.
3	"(D) DISTRIBUTION OF REDUCTION
4	AMOUNTS.—The Secretary may make any
5	amounts in the Account remaining as a result
6	of any reduction in the percentage of amounts
7	under subparagraph (B) available to other cov-
8	ered units or the regions in which the covered
9	units are located for the purposes described in
10	subparagraph (E), taking into consideration the
11	following factors:
12	<del>"(i)</del> Any backlog in ski area permit
13	and Program administration in the covered
14	units, including—
15	"(I) the number of proposals for
16	ski area improvement projects; and
17	"(II) the processing of proposals
18	for ski area improvement projects.
19	"(ii) Any need for services, training,
20	staffing, or the streamlining of programs
21	in the other covered units or the region in
22	which the covered units are located that
23	would improve the administration of the
24	<del>Program.</del>

1	"(iii) Any need for wildfire prepared-
2	ness, planning, and coordination in and
3	around ski areas.
4	"(E) AUTHORIZED EXPENDITURES.—
5	Amounts distributed from the Account to a cov-
6	ered unit under this subsection may be used
7	<del>for</del>
8	<del>"(i)</del> ski area special use permit and
9	Program administration in the covered
10	unit, including—
11	"(I) the processing of proposals
12	for ski area improvement projects:
13	and
14	"(H) staffing and contracting for
15	that processing and related services in
16	the covered unit or in the applicable
17	<del>region;</del>
18	"(ii) staff training for processing of
19	ski area applications and administering ski
20	area permits in the covered unit or the re-
21	gion in which the covered unit is located;
22	"(iii) interpretation activities, visitor
23	information, visitor services, and signage in
24	the covered unit to enhance the ski area

1	visitor experience on National Forest Sys-
2	tem land; and
3	"(iv) wildfire preparedness, planning
4	and coordination in and around ski areas
5	in the covered unit or in the applicable re-
6	<del>gion.</del>
7	"(F) EXPENDITURE FOR OTHER PUR-
8	Poses.—If any amounts remain in the Account
9	after all necessary Program expenditures have
10	been made under subparagraph (D), the Sec-
11	retary may use the amounts for other purposes
12	in accordance with subparagraph (G).
13	"(G) OTHER RECREATION PERMIT ADMIN
14	ISTRATION, VISITOR SERVICES, AND OTHER
15	PURPOSES.—In addition to any amounts re-
16	maining in the Account described in subpara-
17	graph (F), 25 percent of the amounts deposited
18	in the Account from a covered unit in which the
19	rental charges were collected shall remain avail-
20	able for expenditure at that covered unit or the
21	region in which the covered unit is located for—
22	"(i) administering non-ski area Forest
23	Service recreation special use permits;

1	"(ii) avalanche information and edu-
2	cation activities carried out by the Sec-
3	retary or nonprofit partners;
4	"(iii) recreation management, mainte-
5	nance, and services; and
6	"(iv) administration of leases under—
7	"(I) the Forest Service Facility
8	Realignment and Enhancement Act of
9	2005 (16 U.S.C. 580d note; Public
10	Law 109–54); and
11	"(II) section 8623 of the Agri-
12	culture Improvement Act of 2018 (16
13	U.S.C. 580d note; Public Law 115-
14	<del>334).</del>
15	"(H) LIMITATION. Amounts in the Ac-
16	count may not be used for—
17	"(i) the conduct of wildfire suppres-
18	sion outside ski area permit boundaries; or
19	"(ii) the acquisition of land for inclu-
20	sion in the National Forest System.
21	"(5) Savings Provisions.—
22	"(A) In GENERAL.—Nothing in this sub-
23	section affects the applicability of section 7 of
24	the Act of April 24, 1950 (commonly known as

- the 'Granger-Thye Act') (16 U.S.C. 580d), to

  ski areas on National Forest System land.
- 3 "(B) SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING.—Rental
  4 charges retained and expended under this sub5 section shall supplement (and not supplant) ap6 propriated funding for the operation and main7 tenance of each covered unit.
- 8 "(C) COST RECOVERY.—Nothing in this
  9 subsection affects any cost recovery under any
  10 other provision of law for processing applica11 tions for or monitoring compliance with ski area
  12 permits or other recreation special use per13 mits.".
- 14 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This section (including the 15 amendments made by this section) shall take effect on the 16 date that is 60 days after the date of enactment of this 17 Act.
- 18 (e) IMPLEMENTATION.—The Secretary of Agriculture
  19 shall not be required to issue regulations or policy guid20 ance to implement this section (including the amendments
  21 made by this section).

2	COUNT.
3	(a) In General.—Section 701 of division I of the Om-
4	nibus Parks and Public Lands Management Act of 1996
5	(16 U.S.C. 497c) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
6	lowing:
7	"(k) Ski Area Fee Retention Account.—
8	"(1) Definitions.—In this subsection:
9	"(A) Account.—The term 'Account' means
10	the Ski Area Fee Retention Account established
11	under paragraph (2).
12	"(B) Covered unit.—The term 'covered
13	unit' means the unit of the National Forest Sys-
14	tem that collects the ski area permit rental
15	charge under this section.
16	"(C) Secretary.—The term 'Secretary'
17	means the Secretary of Agriculture.
18	"(2) Establishment.—The Secretary of the
19	Treasury shall establish a special account in the
20	Treasury, to be known as the 'Ski Area Fee Retention
21	Account'.
22	"(3) Deposits.—Subject to paragraphs (4) and
23	(5), a ski area permit rental charge collected by the
24	Secretary under this section shall—
25	"(A) be deposited in the Account:

1	"(B) be available to the Secretary for use,
2	without further appropriation; and
3	"(C) remain available for the period of 4
4	fiscal years beginning with the first fiscal year
5	after the fiscal year in which the ski area permit
6	rental charge is deposited in the Account under
7	subparagraph (A).
8	"(4) Distribution of amounts in the ac-
9	COUNT.—
10	"(A) Local distribution of funds.—
11	"(i) In general.—Except as provided
12	in subparagraph (C), the Secretary shall ex-
13	pend 80 percent of the ski area permit rent-
14	al charges deposited in the Account from a
15	covered unit at the covered unit in accord-
16	ance with clause (ii).
17	"(ii) Distribution.—Of the amounts
18	made available for expenditure under clause
19	(i)—
20	"(I) 75 percent shall be used at
21	the covered unit for activities described
22	in paragraph (5)(A); and
23	"(II) 25 percent shall be used for
24	activities at the covered unit described
25	in paragraph $(5)(B)$ .

"(B) AGENCY-WIDE DISTRIBUTION OFFUNDS.—The Secretary shall expend 20 percent of the ski area permit rental charges deposited in the Account from a covered unit at any unit of the National Forest System for an activity de-scribed in subparagraph (A) or (B) of paragraph (5).

#### "(C) Reduction of Percentage.—

"(i) REDUCTION.—The Secretary shall reduce the percentage otherwise applicable under subparagraph (A)(i) to not less than 60 percent if the Secretary determines that the amount otherwise made available under that subparagraph exceeds the reasonable needs of the covered unit for which expenditures may be made in the applicable fiscal year.

"(ii) DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS.—The balance of the ski area permit rental charges that are collected at a covered unit, deposited into the Account, and not distributed in accordance with subparagraph (A) or (B) shall be available to the Secretary for expenditure at any other unit of the Na-

1	tional Forest System in accordance with the
2	following:
3	"(I) 75 percent shall be used for
4	activities described in paragraph
5	(5)(A).
6	"(II) 25 percent shall be used for
7	activities described in paragraph
8	(5)(B).
9	"(5) Expenditures.—Amounts available to the
10	Secretary for expenditure from the Account shall be
11	only used for—
12	"(A)(i) the administration of the Forest
13	Service ski area program, including—
14	"(I) the processing of an application
15	for a new ski area or a ski area improve-
16	ment project, including staffing and con-
17	tracting for the processing; and
18	"(II) administering a ski area permit
19	described in subsection (a);
20	"(ii) staff training for—
21	"(I) the processing of an application
22	for—
23	"(aa) a new ski area;
24	"(bb) a ski area improvement
25	project; or

1	"(cc) a special use permit; or
2	"(II) administering—
3	"(aa) a ski area permit described
4	in subsection (a); or
5	"(bb) a special use permit;
6	"(iii) an interpretation activity, National
7	Forest System visitor information, a visitor serv-
8	ice, or signage;
9	"(iv) direct costs associated with collecting
10	a ski area permit rental charge or other fee col-
11	lected by the Secretary related to recreation;
12	"(v) planning for, or coordinating to re-
13	spond to, a wildfire in or adjacent to a recre-
14	ation site, particularly a ski area; or
15	"(vi) reducing the likelihood of a wildfire
16	starting, or the risks posed by a wildfire, in or
17	adjacent to a recreation site, particularly a ski
18	area, except through hazardous fuels reduction
19	activities; or
20	"(B)(i) the repair, maintenance, or enhancement
21	of a Forest Service-owned facility, road, or trail di-
22	rectly related to visitor enjoyment, visitor access, or
23	visitor health or safety;
24	"(ii) habitat restoration directly related to recre-
25	ation;

1	"(iii) law enforcement related to public use and
2	recreation;
3	"(iv) the construction or expansion of parking
4	areas;
5	"(v) the processing or administering of a recre-
6	ation special use permit;
7	"(vi) avalanche information and education ac-
8	tivities carried out by the Secretary or nonprofit
9	partners;
10	"(vii) search and rescue activities carried out by
11	the Secretary, a local government, or a nonprofit
12	partner; or
13	"(viii) the administration of leases under—
14	"(I) the Forest Service Facility Realign-
15	ment and Enhancement Act of 2005 (16 U.S.C.
16	580d note; Public Law 109-54); and
17	"(II) section 8623 of the Agriculture Im-
18	provement Act of 2018 (16 U.S.C. 580d note;
19	Public Law 115–334).
20	"(6) Limitation.—Amounts in the Account may
21	not be used for—
22	"(A) the conduct of wildfire suppression; or
23	"(B) the acquisition of land for inclusion in
24	the National Forest System.
25	"(7) Effect.—

- 1 "(A) IN GENERAL.—Nothing in this sub2 section affects the applicability of section 7 of the
  3 Act of April 24, 1950 (commonly known as the
  4 'Granger-Thye Act') (16 U.S.C. 580d), to ski
  5 areas on National Forest System land.
  - "(B) Supplemental funding.—Rental charges retained and expended under this subsection shall supplement (and not supplant) appropriated funding for the operation and maintenance of each covered unit.
  - "(C) Cost recovery.—Nothing in this subsection affects any cost recovery under any provision of law (including regulations) for processing an application for or monitoring compliance with a ski area permit or other recreation special use permit."
- 17 (b) Effective Date.—This section (including the 18 amendments made by this section) shall take effect on the 19 date that is 60 days after the date of enactment of this Act.
