3	STUDY ON REDUCING TRAFFIC CONGESTION NEAR FORT BRAGG.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> There is appropriated from the Highway Fund to the Department of
6	Transportation for the 2025-2026 fiscal year the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000)
7	in nonrecurring funds to be used by the Department to study and identify the economic benefits
8	from reducing the traffic congestion on the portion of road between the intersection of Vass Road
9	and N.C. Highway 87 and the entrance to Fort Bragg. The study shall include examining
10	expanded rail routes and other surface transportation.
11	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2025.
