A BILL

To prohibit certain individuals from downloading or using TikTok on any device issued by the United States or a government corporation.

- 3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "No TikTok on Govern-
- 5 ment Devices Act".

SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON DOWNLOADING OR USING TIKTOK 2 BY FEDERAL EMPLOYEES. 3 (a) In General.—Except as provided in subsection (b), no employee of the United States, officer of the 4 5 United States, Member of Congress, congressional employee, or officer or employee of a government corporation 7 may download or use TikTok or any successor application developed by ByteDance or any entity owned by ByteDance on any device issued by the United States or a government corporation. 11 (b) EXCEPTION.—Subsection (a) shall not apply to any investigation, eybersecurity research activity, enforcement action, disciplinary action, or intelligence activity. 9	tor of the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security				
0	Agency, the Director of National Intelligence, and the				
1	Secretary of Defense, and consistent with the informa-

4	velop standards and guidelines for executive agencies
