It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 20-13-12 of the General Laws in Chapter 20-13 entitled "Hunting

2 and Hunting Safety" is hereby amended to read as follows:

20-13-12. Reports of hunting injuries.

4 Every person <u>causing</u> <u>who sustains</u> an injury to <u>themselves or causes injury to another</u> <u>a</u>

human being by gunfire while hunting or trapping or inflicting an injury upon himself or herself

6 with firearms while hunting or inflicting an injury upon himself or herself while trapping shall

7 make a report to the department of environmental management immediately within seventy two

(72) hours after the injury, unless that person is physically incapable of making the required

report, in which event it is the duty of that person to designate some other person to file the report

within the specified time.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
