## A BILL

- To require the Social Security Administration to make changes to the social security terminology used in the rules, regulation, guidance, or other materials of the Administration.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
  - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
  - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Claiming Age Clarity
  - 5 Act".
  - 6 SEC. 2. CHANGES TO SOCIAL SECURITY TERMINOLOGY.
  - 7 Not later than January 1, 2025, the Commissioner
  - 8 of Social Security shall ensure that, in any rules, regula-

1 tion, guidance, or other materials of the Social Security Administration, whether online or in print— 3 (1) the term "early eligibility age" is replaced with the term "minimum monthly benefit age"; 4 (2) the terms "full retirement age" and "nor-5 mal retirement age" are replaced with the term 6 "standard monthly benefit age"; and 7 (3) the term "delayed retirement credit" shall 8 not be used and any reference to age 70 as the max-9 imum age up to which delayed retirement credits 10 can be received shall be replaced with the term 11 "maximum monthly benefit age". 12
