## A BILL

To require the Secretary of the Interior to remove the Emancipation Memorial from Lincoln Park in the District of Columbia, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Emancipation Statue
- 5 Removal Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. REMOVAL OF EMANCIPATION MEMORIAL.
- 7 (a) Removal.—The Secretary of the Interior shall
- 8 ensure that the Emancipation Memorial is removed from
- 9 Lincoln Park in the District of Columbia.

- 1 (b) Donation.—The Secretary shall donate the
- 2 Emancipation Memorial to a museum or other similar en-
- 3 tity. The recipient of the Emancipation Memorial may not
- 4 store, display, or exhibit the Emancipation Memorial out-
- 5 side. If the Emancipation Memorial is stored, displayed,
- 6 or exhibited outside, ownership of the Emancipation Me-
- 7 morial will revert back to the Federal Government.
