- 3 SECTION 1. LIABILITY OF COVID-19 VACCINE MANUFAC-
- 4 TURERS.
- 5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in apply-
- 6 ing section XII of the "Declaration Under the Public
- 7 Readiness and Emergency Preparedness Act for Medical
- 8 Countermeasures Against COVID-19" issued pursuant to

- 1 section 319F–3(b)(2)(B) of the Public Health Service Act
- 2 (42 U.S.C. 247d-6d(b)(2)(B)), with respect to manufac-
- 3 turers of COVID-19 vaccines, the reference to October 1,
- 4 2024, shall be deemed a reference to December 1, 2021.

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
