- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. RESCISSION.

- The provisions of Executive Order 13769 (82 Fed.
- 3 Reg. 8977; January 27, 2017), entitled "Protecting the
- 4 Nation from Foreign Terrorist Entry into the United
- 5 States", are rescinded and shall not have any legal effect.

6 SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- 7 This Act shall take effect as if enacted on January
- 8 27, 2017.
