1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the penalty for ingestion of marijuana. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 2 3 Section 1. That subdivision (20) of § 34-20B-14 be amended to read: Tetrahydrocannabinol, other than that which occurs in marijuana in its natural and 4 5 unaltered state, including any compound, except nabilone or compounds listed under a different schedule, structurally derived from 6,6' dimethyl-benzo[c]chromene by 6 7 substitution at the 3-position with either alkyl (C3 to C8), methyl cycloalkyl, or 8 adamantyl groups, whether or not the compound is further modified in any of the 9 following ways: 10 By partial to complete saturation of the C-ring; or 11 By substitution at the 1-position with a hydroxyl or methoxy group; or 12 By substitution at the 9-position with a hydroxyl, methyl, or methylhydoxyl 13 group; or

By modification of the possible 3-alkyl group with a 1,1' dimethyl moiety, a
