A BILL

- To amend the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 to provide death benefits for campus police officers.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Officer Sean Collier
 - 5 Campus Police Recognition Act of 2019".
 - 6 SEC. 2. DEATH BENEFITS FOR CAMPUS POLICE OFFICERS.
 - 7 Section 1204 of part L of title I of the Omnibus
 - 8 Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C.
 - 9 10284) is amended—

1	(1) by redesignating paragraphs (1) through
2	(9) as paragraphs (2) through (10), respectively;
3	(2) by inserting the following before paragraph
4	(2) (as so redesignated):
5	"(1) 'campus police officer' means a police offi-
6	cer—
7	"(A) who is authorized to enforce the
8	criminal laws (including the authorization to
9	make arrests); and
10	"(B) who is employed by an institution of
11	higher education (as such term is defined in
12	section 101 of the Higher Education Act of
13	1965), including a police or similar department
14	operated by such institution;"; and
15	(3) in paragraph (10) (as so redesignated)—
16	(A) in subparagraph (C)(ii), by striking
17	"or" at the end;
18	(B) in subparagraph (D), by striking the
19	period at the end and inserting "; or"; and
20	(C) by inserting after subparagraph (D)
21	the following:
22	"(E) a campus police officer.".
23	SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.
24	The amendments made by this Act shall apply with
25	respect to a personal injury sustained in the line of duty

- 1 by a campus police officer occurring on or after April 15,
- 2 2013.
