A BILL

To prohibit certain Federal funding from being used for certain cash assistance programs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stop Disincentivizing
5 Work Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON FUNDING.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—None of the funds made available
8 under any of the Acts specified in subsection (b) may be
9 used for recurring cash assistance programs to individuals
10 or households.
