A BILL

To clarify the rights of Indians and Indian tribes on Indian lands under the National Labor Relations Act.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Tribal Labor Sov-
- 5 ereignty Act of 2017".

1 SEC. 2. DEFINITION OF EMPLOYER.

2	Section 2 of the National Labor Relations Act (29
3	U.S.C. 152) is amended—
4	(1) in paragraph (2), by inserting "or any In-
5	dian tribe, or any enterprise or institution owned
6	and operated by an Indian tribe and located on its
7	Indian lands," after "subdivision thereof,"; and
8	(2) by adding at the end the following:
9	"(15) The term 'Indian tribe' means any Indian
10	tribe, band, nation, pueblo, or other organized group
11	or community which is recognized as eligible for the
12	special programs and services provided by the
13	United States to Indians because of their status as
14	Indians.
15	"(16) The term 'Indian' means any individual
16	who is a member of an Indian tribe.
17	"(17) The term 'Indian lands' means—
18	"(A) all lands within the limits of any In-
19	dian reservation;
20	"(B) any lands title to which is either held
21	in trust by the United States for the benefit of
22	any Indian tribe or individual or held by any
23	Indian tribe or individual subject to restriction
24	by the United States against alienation; and
25	"(C) any lands in the State of Oklahoma
26	that are within the boundaries of a former res-
