A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Dorchester County Board of Education – Nonprofessional Personnel**
3 **Appointment – Advice and Consent**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Dorchester County Superintendent of Schools to appoint
5 certain clerical and nonprofessional personnel with the advice and consent of the
6 Dorchester County Board of Education; and generally relating to the Dorchester
7 County Board of Education.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Education**

16 6–201.

17 (c) (1) Except in **DORCHESTER COUNTY**, Worcester County, and Baltimore
18 City, the county superintendent shall appoint clerical and other nonprofessional personnel.

19 (2) In **DORCHESTER COUNTY AND** Worcester County, the County
20 Superintendent shall appoint clerical and other nonprofessional personnel with the advice
21 and consent of the county board.

22 (3) Notwithstanding any provision of local law, in Baltimore City, the
23 appointment, tenure, and compensation of clerical and other nonprofessional personnel

2 City Board of School Commissioners under § 4–311 of this article.
