A BILL

To amend the Clean Air Act to repeal the natural gas tax.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- This Act may be cited as the "Natural Gas Tax Re-
- 5 peal Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. REPEAL.
- 7 Section 136 of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. 7436)
- 8 (relating to methane emissions and waste reduction incen-

- 1 tive program for petroleum and natural gas systems) is
- 2 repealed.
- 3 SEC. 3. RESCISSION.
- 4 The unobligated balance of any amounts made avail-
- 5 able under section 136 of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C.
- 6 7436) (as in effect on the day before the date of enactment
- 7 of this Act) is rescinded.
