- 3 SECTION 1. PLACEMENT OF STATUES FROM TERRITORIES
- 4 IN NATIONAL STATUARY HALL.
- 5 (a) Placement of Statues.—Section 1814 of the
- 6 Revised Statutes of the United States (2 U.S.C. 2131)
- 7 is amended by adding at the end the following new sen-
- 8 tence: "For purposes of this section, the term 'State' in-
- 9 cludes American Samoa, Guam, the Commonwealth of the

- 1 Northern Mariana Islands, the Commonwealth of Puerto
- 2 Rico, and the United States Virgin Islands.".
- 3 (b) Conforming Amendment Relating to Re-
- 4 PLACEMENT OF STATUES.—Section 311 of the Legislative
- 5 Branch Appropriations Act, 2001 (2 U.S.C. 2132) is
- 6 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
- 7 section:
- 8 "(f) For purposes of this section, the term 'State' in-
- 9 cludes American Samoa, Guam, the Commonwealth of the
- 10 Northern Mariana Islands, the Commonwealth of Puerto
- 11 Rico, and the United States Virgin Islands.".
