1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to place certain substances on the controlled substance
2 schedules and to declare an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 34-20B-13 be amended to read:

14 Section 4. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,
15 health, or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in full force and
16 effect from and after its passage and approval.
