## Maryland Transit Administration – Transit Ridership of Executive Branch Employees – Fare Required

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Maryland Transit Administration from allowing an 5 employee of the Executive Branch of State government to use a transit service 6 without paying the established fare; authorizing the Administration to allow, under 7 certain circumstances, an employee of the Executive Branch of State government to 8 use a transit service without payment of a certain fare; requiring the Administration, 9 each fiscal year, to estimate the total amount of fares recovered from employees of the Executive Branch of State government; requiring the Administration to 10 11 reimburse local governments and boards of education certain amounts; providing 12 that the Administration may not provide reimbursements that in the aggregate 13 exceed a certain estimate; providing that if a certain estimate exceeds a certain 14 amount the Administration must use the excess for certain purposes; providing for 15 a delayed effective date; and generally relating to a requirement that certain 16 employees of the Executive Branch of State government pay certain established fares 17 for certain transit services.

23 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 1 (A) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, 2 THE ADMINISTRATION MANY NOT ALLOW AN EMPLOYEE OF THE EXECUTIVE
- 3 Branch of State Government to use a transit service without payment
- 4 OF THE ESTABLISHED FARE FOR THE USE OF THE TRANSIT SERVICE.
- 5 (2) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ALLOW AN EMPLOYEE OF THE

- 12 (I) ESTIMATE THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF INCREASED REVENUE
- 13 FROM FARES PAID BY EMPLOYEES OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF STATE
- 14 GOVERNMENT; AND
- 15 (II) FROM THE INCREASE IN REVENUE FROM FARES UNDER
- 16 SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, REIMBURSE A LOCAL GOVERNMENT OR BOARD
- 17 OF EDUCATION THAT PAYS:
- 18 1. A FARE, FEE, OR OTHER CHARGE TO THE
- 19 ADMINISTRATION FOR TRANSPORTING STUDENTS TO OR FROM A PUBLIC SCHOOL IN
- 20 THE STATE; OR
- 2. A TOLL, FEE, OR OTHER CHARGE TO THE MARYLAND
- 22 TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY IN THE COURSE OF TRANSPORTING STUDENTS TO
- 23 OR FROM A PUBLIC SCHOOL IN THE STATE.
- 24 (2) FOR ANY FISCAL YEAR, THE ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT PROVIDE
- 25 REIMBURSEMENTS UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)(II) OF THIS SUBSECTION THAT IN THE
- 26 AGGREGATE EXCEED THE AMOUNT ESTIMATED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)(I) OF THIS
- 27 SUBSECTION.
- 28 (3) IF THE AMOUNT ESTIMATED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)(I) OF THIS
- 29 SUBSECTION EXCEEDS THE REIMBURSEMENTS MADE UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)(II) OF
- 30 THIS SUBSECTION, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL USE THE REMAINDER FOR THE
- 31 SAME PURPOSES AS OTHER FARES AND OPERATING REVENUE RECOVERED BY THE
- 32 ADMINISTRATION.
- 33 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
- 34 1, 2018.
