CHAPTER

1 AN ACT concerning

State Vehicle Fleet - Conversion to Zero-Emission Electric Passenger Cars and Other Light-Duty Vehicles

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting, beginning in a certain fiscal year, a State unit from entering into a contract to purchase or lease a vehicle for the State vehicle fleet that 5 is not a zero-emission electric vehicle; establishing the intent of the General 6 7 Assembly that a certain percentage of passenger cars and other light-duty vehicles 8 in the State vehicle fleet be zero-emission vehicles by certain years; requiring the 9 State to ensure that a certain minimum percentage of passenger cars and other light-duty vehicles purchased for the State vehicle fleet in certain fiscal years are 10 zero-emission vehicles, subject to the availability of funding; requiring the 11 12 Department of General Services to ensure the development of certain charging infrastructure; requiring the Chief Procurement Officer to submit a certain report to 13 14 the General Assembly on or before a certain date each year; requiring certain units to cooperate with the Chief Procurement Officer in the collection and reporting of 15 16 certain information; providing for the application of this Act; defining certain terms; 17 and generally relating to the State vehicle fleet and zero-emission electric passenger 18 cars and other light-duty vehicles.
