6 WHEREAS, highest commendations and congratulations
7 are herein proudly presented to Joseph Bradley on his
8 outstanding achievement of winning a gold medal by taking
9 first place in the English Equitation event at the 2019
10 Special Olympics World Games in Abu Dhabi; he also won two
11 bronze medals in the English Working Trails and Dressage
12 events; and

13 WHEREAS, Joseph is a senior at Jefferson Davis High
14 School; he is an amazing young man who has overcome trauma and
15 many life-threatening injuries he suffered from being abused
16 at a very young age; and

17 WHEREAS, in 2011, he became very interested in
18 riding horses; he was selected for the international games
19 after winning the state's Special Olympics in equestrian in
20 May 2018; he is the first Alabamian to be selected to attend
21 the world games in at least 10 years; the 2019 Special
22 Olympics World Summer Games, held March 14-21, were the first
23 Special Olympics games to take place in the Middle East and
24 the largest sports and humanitarian event recorded, featuring

1 200 nations, more than 7,000 athletes and 20,000 registered
2 volunteers; now therefore,
