 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. TECHNICAL AMENDMENT.
 - 4 (a) Short Title.—This section may be cited as the
 - 5 "Ukpeagvik Inupiat Corporation Gravel Exchange
 - 6 Amendment Act".
 - 7 (b) Identification and Transfer of Gravel
 - 8 Sources.—Section 3 of the Barrow Gas Field Transfer

- 1 Act of 1984 (Public Law 98–366, 98 Stat. 468) is amend-
- 2 ed by adding at the end the following: "The foregoing con-
- 3 veyance to UIC shall include all right, title, and interest
- 4 held by the United States to sand and gravel deposits un-
- 5 derlying the surface estate owned by UIC contiguous to
- 6 the Barrow gas fields, more particularly described as the
- 7 sand and gravel deposits underlying that UIC surface es-
- 8 tate lying within T 21N R16W, sections 7, 17–18, 19–
- 9 21, and 28–29; T 21N R17W, sections 1–2, and 11–14;
- 10 T 22N, R18W, sections 4, 9, and 29-32; and T 22N
- 11 R19W, sections 25 and 36.".
