- 5 (B) IF A CLINICAL STAFFING PLAN FOR A UNIT IS AMENDED AFTER IT IS
 6 IMPLEMENTED, THE HOSPITAL SHALL POST OR PROVIDE THE AMENDED CLINICAL
 7 STAFFING PLAN FOR THE UNIT IN THE MANNER REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A)
 8 OF THIS SECTION, IN A TIMELY MANNER.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That each hospital shall establish 10 a clinical staffing committee as required under § 19–388 of the Health General Article, 11 as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, on or before January 1, 2026.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That each clinical staffing committee shall develop a clinical staffing plan as required under § 19–388 of the Health General Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, on or before July 1, 2026.
- SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 October 1, 2025.
