A BILL

To prohibit the provision of Federal funds to a local educational agency unless in-person instruction is available to all students at the schools served by the agency.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON FEDERAL FUNDS FOR CER-
- 4 TAIN LOCAL EDUCATIONAL AGENCIES.
- 5 (a) In General.—No Federal funds shall be pro-
- 6 vided to a local educational agency unless in-person in-
- 7 struction is available to all students at each public elemen-
- 8 tary school and secondary school under the jurisdiction of
- 9 the local educational agency.

- 1 (b) Definitions.—In this Act, the terms "elemen-
- 2 tary school", "local educational agency", and "secondary
- 3 school" have the meanings given such terms in section
- 4 8101 of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of

5 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7801).
