SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 2 This Act may be cited as the "Veterans Equal Treat-
- 3 ment Ensures Relief and Access Now Act" or the "VET-

- 5 SEC. 2. CLARIFICATION RELATING TO VETERAN HEALTH
- 6 INSURANCE AND ELIGIBILITY FOR PREMIUM
- 7 TAX CREDIT.
- 8 (a) Amendment of Pre-2020 Credit.—
- 9 (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 36B(c)(2)(B)(i) of 10 the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, prior to any 11 amendment by section 214 of the American Health 12 Care Act of 2017, is amended by adding at the end 13 the following: "For purposes of the preceding sen-14 tence, an individual shall not be treated as eligible 15 for coverage described in section 5000A(f)(1)(A)(v)
- 17 (2) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made 18 by this subsection shall apply to taxable years end-19 ing after December 31, 2013.

unless such individual is enrolled in such coverage.".

- 20 (b) Amendment of Post-2019 Credit.—
- 21 (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 36B(d) of such 22 Code, as amended by section 214 of the American 23 Health Care Act of 2017 and in effect for months 24 beginning after December 31, 2019, is amended by 25 adding at the end the following:

- 1 "For purposes of paragraph (2)(B), an individual shall
- 2 not be treated as eligible for coverage described in section
- 3 5000A(f)(1)(A)(v) unless such individual is enrolled in
- 4 such coverage.".
- 5 (2) Effective date.—The amendment made
- 6 by this subsection is contingent upon the enactment
- 7 of the American Health Care Act of 2017 and shall
- 8 apply (if at all) to months beginning after December
- 9 31, 2019, in taxable years ending after such date.
