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1	AN ACT relating to the establishment of a grant database.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 42 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) As used in this section:
6	(a) "Agency" means any state or local governmental department, cabinet,
7	institution, board, commission, office, or any other unit of government; and
8	(b) "Grant" means money, equipment, material, or services that may be
9	available to an individual or entity from any agency through an application
10	process administered by the agency.
11	(2) The Finance and Administration Cabinet shall establish a grant database that
12	shall serve as a single, unified entry point for individuals and entities to access
13	and review grant opportunities that are eligible for application. The database
14	<u>shall:</u>
15	(a) Include the ability to use keyword searches to discover all available grant
16	opportunities; and
17	(b) Provide in the information section of the related grant all information
18	reported by agencies as required under subsection (4) of this section.
19	(3) The primary goals of the grant database include:
20	(a) Ensuring state and local grants are easily accessible for individuals and
21	entities of the Commonwealth; and
22	(b) Clearly stating requirements for grants to ensure submissions are qualified
23	for the potential grant.
24	(4) Beginning December 1, 2025, all agencies shall report quarterly to the Finance
25	and Administration Cabinet the grant opportunities that are currently available
26	from their agency. The report shall include:
27	(a) The title of the grant;

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1	(b) The statute or administrative regulation that authorizes the grant;
2	(c) The posting date of the grant;
3	(d) The deadline for applying for the grant;
4	(e) The eligibility criteria for the grant;
5	(f) The total funds available, including the maximum and minimum amounts a
6	grant recipient could receive;
7	(g) The grantor's contact information; and
8	(h) Any other information that may assist in the identification and orderly
9	allocation of grant funds.
10	(5) Each county and area development district shall display a link to the grant
11	database prominently on the homepage or first page of its website.
