To amend section 3116 of title 5, United States Code, to clarify the applicability of the appointment limitations for students appointed under the expedited hiring authority for post-secondary students.

- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. CLARIFICATION OF LIMITATION ON EXPE-
- 4 DITED HIRING AUTHORITY FOR POST-SEC-
- 5 ONDARY STUDENTS.
- 6 Section 3116(d)(1) of title 5, United States Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:

"(1) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in para-1 2 graph (2), the total number of students that the 3 head of an agency may appoint under this section 4 during a fiscal year may not exceed the number equal to 15 percent of the number of students that 5 6 the agency head appointed during the previous fiscal year to a position at the GS-11 level, or an equiva-7 lent level, or below.". 8
